Technical Requirements

Fire Up Your Life!

Following are instructions for light and sound needs.

The last paragraph of the Introduction reads as follows:

“Let me first set the scene. It is March 1, 1978. We are at the Los Angeles International Airport. Donna Hartley, the actress and former Miss Hawaii, is boarding a flight to Honolulu to emcee the Miss Hawaii Pageant. On this day her spiritual journey began and life changed forever.”

Sound: When you hear *“life changed forever”* play CD, loud.
Estimated play time, 2 minutes 50 seconds.

Lights: When you hear *“life changed forever”* **all lights go out** in room.
Estimated time lights are out: 2 minutes 50 seconds.

Remote Mouse: Will be needed to control the Power Point to be played from computer. There is a blank between each picture. About 7 slides. First slide comes up when CD is playing, about 1 minute and 30 seconds into it, it's the plane crash picture.

Sound: Fade out after the last words of CD which are *“I want to live”* followed by ambulance sirens. No more audio requirements.

Remote Mouse: Move forward to blank screen when I walk on stage.

Remote Mouse: About 5 minutes into my live speech, I need the next picture up which is of the plane crash. Estimated time picture is up 4 minutes. Turn off when I get to *“I leave L.A. and go back to Hawaii on my next flight, which is not Continental, when I go to emcee the Miss Hawaii pageant”*

All pictures are off until the last 15 minutes of my speech. When I talk about the adoption of my daughter I will say *“I'd like to introduce you to my daughter”* the pictures will start.
